Boombah Helmet Modification Policies

Decal Issues:

Boombah has tested certain small pressure sensitive decals and labels for use on Boombah helmets. In our testing, these decals did not degrade the plastic used for Boombah helmets.

You should be aware:

- Decals which cover a surface area more than 20% of the exterior may attack the polymer used in Boombah helmets.
- Use of cleaners, additional adhesives, and additional coatings on top of the decals may be detrimental to the helmets.
- Manufacturers of decals use different adhesives and change those adhesives often. We can only test the decals we provide.
- Decals cannot cover the Boombah logo, any warnings, date of manufacture, or the NOCSAE certification mark.
- Many umpires object to any decals on helmets as the decals may hide cracks or weaknesses in the helmets.
- Use of decals outside of this policy will void the Boombah warranty on the helmets.

Painting issues:

Boombah strongly advises against any painting, airbrushing, or coloring of the helmets. Some paints can cause shell deterioration, which would adversely affect player safety. Boombah helmets are offered in great colors and are NOSCAE certified using only Boombah approved coatings.

The use of paint or other coatings will void the Boombah warranty.
